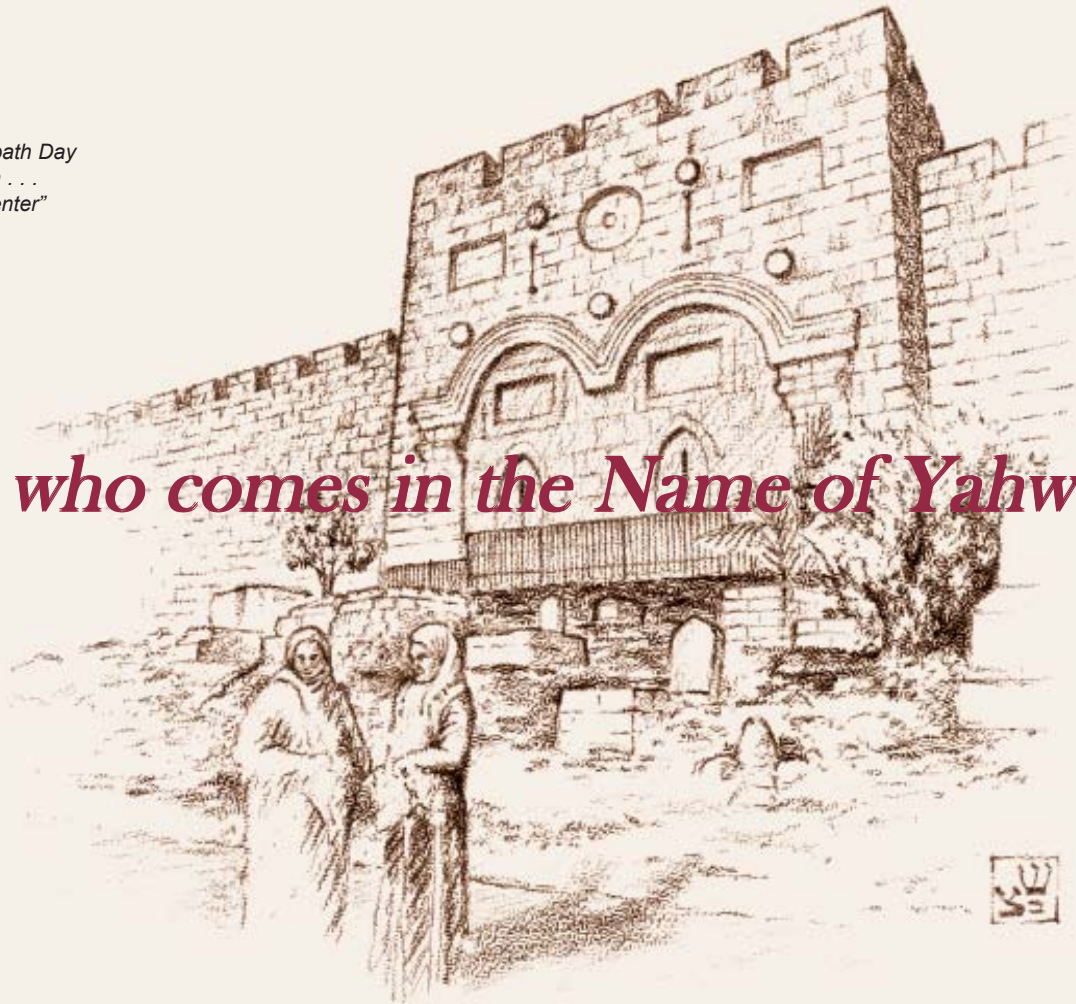

The Holy Sabbath is a twenty-five hour day, borrowing from the sixth day and from the first day. It begins when the sun is reaching the horizon, and ends after complete sunset. It requires preparation before the end of the sixth day. This ancient understanding has prophetic significance seen in Revelation.






There are four New Years on the Hebrew calendar:

 Shevat 15 - New Year for Trees (Arbor Day).





