Yeshua was crucified on the Preparation day, raised three days later, and ascended after forty days - the same date the waters of the great flood were dried off the earth.

On Yom haKippurim / the Day of the Atonements, two goats represent the two atonements - our sins being imputed to Yeshua and taken away, and His righteousness being imputed to us with the aroma ascending to heaven.
